



**WHEREAS** the Guaranty Act provides that

All proceedings involving covered claims in which the insolvent insurer is a party or is obligated to defend a party in any court in this State must be stayed ninety days from the date insolvency is determined to permit proper defense by the association.

§ 38-31-160.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that the Commission shall not make any rulings, issue any opinions, orders, or awards, or take any other judicial action in any claim in which Ullico Casualty Company is a party until August 27<sup>th</sup>, 2013, which is 90 days from the date of the entry of the Order of Liquidation, in compliance with § 38-31-160.

**IT IS FURTHERMORE ORDERED** that the Commission's Judicial Department shall place a stay on all pending matters involving Ullico Casualty Company until August 27<sup>th</sup>, 2013.
