### **South Carolina Senate Confirms the Reappointment of Commissioner Aisha Taylor**



The South Carolina Workers' Compensation Commission announces that the South Carolina Senate has confirmed the reappointment of Commissioner Aisha Taylor to serve an additional six-year term on the Commission. Her term will run from June 30, 2026, through June 30, 2032.

Commissioner Taylor was originally appointed to the Commission on January 31, 2013, by Governor Nikki Haley. Prior to her appointment, she practiced law as a shareholder with the law firm Collins & Lacy, where her practice focused primarily on workers' compensation defense and employment law.

Commissioner Taylor graduated from the University of South Carolina in 2002. During her time at the university, she served as team captain of the 2002 Women's Track and Field National Championship Team and was recognized as a four-year SEC Scholar Athlete. She later earned her Juris Doctor from the University of South Carolina School of Law in 2006. Following law school, Commissioner Taylor served as a law clerk to the Honorable Brooks

P. Goldsmith of South Carolina's Sixth Judicial Circuit. She is also a member of the Stanford E. Lacy Workers' Compensation Inn of Court.

Throughout her tenure at the Commission, Commissioner Taylor has contributed to the fair and efficient resolution of workers' compensation claims and has played an important role in the administration of South Carolina's workers' compensation system. The Commission congratulates her on her reappointment and thanks her for her continued service on the Commission and her dedication to the citizens of South Carolina.
